

Regulations

The riders are identified by their helmet colours. Start-line positions are: Red (inside), Blue, White, Yellow and Black (outside). The winner of each heat gains three points, second two points, third one point. The over-all winner will be the rider achieving the highest total of points for the meeting.

All heats are raced over four laps.

In the event of a tie for first, second or third place, a deciding race (or races) will be held after Heat 20.

The 4 lap Track Record is 1m 9.2s held by Ivan Mauger (New Zealand)

Track Length: 408 metres

OFFICIAL F.I.M. STARTING RULE

F.I.M. regulation 21.66.1:

"... A driver who breaks one tape or the tapes or crosses the starting line with both wheels of his motorcycle shall be excluded . . . in individual events he shall be replaced by a track reserve.

"If, because of faulty operation of the gate or for any other reason, the Referee considers the start to be incorrect, he shall immediately stop the race with the 'stop' signal and order a re-start in which the drivers shall occupy their original starting positions.

"After the green light has been switched on, no time allowance can be given and no outside assistance can be rendered to drivers except for a driver who has fallen or if the engine stopped after the signal when, after the gate is up, he may be assisted by two pushers for a distance of 30 metres. If, at that point, the engine does not start, the driver in question shall be excluded from the race."
