By tradition, semi-finals are the nights where the adrenalin runs just that little bit faster as the qualifying route hots up for this year's grand spectacular - the championship world individual Gothenburg, Sweden.

Will our fortunes take a turn for the vear? That better underlines, sweetly and succintly, the significance of tonight's meeting.



MIKE LANHAM

MELVYN ROY TAYLOR — b.26.4.1961 — West Row, Suffolk. Rode at Poole three weeks ago, socring three points in King's Lynns 41-37 defeat at Wimborne Road. Scored nine points in the Quarter Final at Halifax to be here tonight. First full year in the senior section with King's Lynn. Hoping to qualify for his first British Final appearance tonight.

NIGEL WILLIAM FLATMAN — b.30.3.1960 — Felixstowe, Suffolk. 20-year-old who rides for National League Peterborough and Ipswich. Was a representative for the Panthers in last years National League Riders Final at Wimbledon. Finished sixth in the World Championship Quarter Final with nine points at Halifax. Another rider wishing for his first British Final appearance.

JAMES DUNN TEMPLETON McMILLAN — b.3.12.1945 — Glasgow, Scotland. Wolverhampton veteran who made his tenth British Final appearance last year but has yet to qualify for a World Final. British Final record: 1968 (8 points); 1969 (7 points); 1970 (2 points); 1972 (10 points); 1973 (2 points); 1974 (8 points); 1975 (5 points); 1976 (8 points); 1978 (3 points); 1979 (4 points). If Jim manages to qualify tonight he will equal the all time record of British Final appearances which at present is held by both Barry Briggs and Nigel Booccock.

GORDON WILLIAM KENNETT — b.2.9.1953 — Bromley, Kent. Qualified to the British Final last year after finishing second in the British Semi-Final at Leicester. Has made four British Final appearances: 1975 (6 points); 1977 (8 points); 1978 (10 points); 1979 (7 points). Finished second in the 1978 World Championship Final at Wembley.

MICHAEL WILLIAM LANHAM — b.2.8.1951 — Ipswich, Suffolk. Winner of the recent World Championship Quarter Final at Halifax. Qualified to the British Final last year but only recorded one point at Coventry. Has made only one


other British Final appearance in 1976 when scoring three points. Part of the very powerful Ipswich side in 1980.

KEVIN ROY HAWKINS — b.21.7.1954 — Buckingham, Buckinghamshire. Joined British League Champions Coventry at the beginning of last season and helped the Bees to their second consecutive title while remaining on loan to National League Nottingham. A full-time Bee in 1980 who finished second in the World Championship Quarter Final at Halifax with thirteen points.

KEVIN GUY JOLLY — b.29.1.1958 — Eye, Suffolk. Started his Speedway career with Mildenhall in 1975 and is now established as a solid heat leader with Ipswich. Had an arm injury at the end of the 1979 season. Could be a surprise qualifyer tonight. Had his first full international cap in 1978 when he rode against the Australasians.

JOHN HARRY DAVIS — b.10.11.1954 — Oxford. Rode in this same meeting last year scoring ten points. Has made four British Final appearances: 1976 (5 points); 1977 (10 points); 1978 (8 points); 1979 (11 points). Ridden at Wimborne Road twice this season. (For Reading on the opening night. In the Christer Sjosten Memorial Meeting). Was knocked out of the 1979 World Championships at White City in the Inter Continental Final. Reserve in the 1977 World Final in Sweden. An ex-Poole rider.

JOHN CHARLES LOUIS — b.14.6.1941 — Ipswich, Suffolk. The fourth Ipswich rider on parade tonight. Finished third in this corresponding fixture last year with eleven points. Reinstated as England skipper with the appearance last week at Wimborne Road against the Americans. Eight British Final appearances: 1972 (11 points); 1973 (7 points); 1974 (8 points); 1975 (15 points—1st); 1976 (11 points); 1977 (6 points); 1978 (3 points); 1979 (6 points).






